

A Curbside space is available at the Early Voting location in front of the Annex.

Procedure for Curbside Voters

Park your vehicle in a designated parking space marked Curbside Voter.

- 1. Press the button (doorbell) provided on the sign for service. You must provide an acceptable form of ID to the clerks assisting you.
- 2. The clerks (usually the judge and alternate) will verify that you are a qualified registered voter using the pollbook containing the Official List of Registered Voters.
- 3. Once you are accepted to vote, the clerks will ask you to sign the pollbook to verify that you meet the qualifications to vote.
- 4. The clerks will return to the inside of the polling place for these items:
- 5. Ballot inserted into a Ballot Privacy Case
- 6. Pen for marking the ballot
- 7. "I Voted" sticker.
- 8. You will be allowed to mark your ballot.
- 9. Once you complete your ballot, you may press the bell again for service.
- 10. The clerks will accept your ballot and deposit it into the ballot box for voted ballots.
- 11. You may leave.
- 12. Thank you for voting!

Note: Only one clerk is required to assist curbside voters during Early Voting.
