



# PROCLAMATION

## From the Office of the Texas Secretary of State

### TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

WHEREAS, Section 2.025 of the Texas Election Code requires the Secretary of State to designate the date of a runoff election resulting from an election held on a uniform election date; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.025(a) and (e) of the Texas Election Code provide that the runoff election shall be held on a Saturday and must occur no earlier than the 30th day after the date of the main election and no later than the 45th day after the date of the main election; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.025(e) of the Texas Election Code provides that the runoff election date designated by the Secretary of State may not be a national or state holiday under Section 1.006(f) of the Texas Election Code or have an early voting period that includes such a holiday; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 41.001 of the Texas Election Code, Saturday, May 2, 2026, is a uniform election date;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JANE NELSON, Secretary of State of Texas, under the authority vested in me by Section 2.025 of the Texas Election Code, do hereby designate Saturday, June 13, 2026, as the date of a runoff election resulting from an election held on Saturday, May 2, 2026.

Early voting by personal appearance for a runoff election held on Saturday, June 13, 2026, shall begin on Monday, June 1, 2026, and end on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, in accordance with Sections 2.025(e) and 85.001(e) of the Texas Election Code.

A copy of this proclamation shall be transmitted to every county judge of this state, and all appropriate writs will be issued, and all proper proceedings will be followed, to the end that runoff elections may be held on Saturday, June 13, 2026, and their results proclaimed in accordance with law.
